

BASSINGHAM NEIGHBOURHOOD

DEVELOPMENT PLAN (BNDP) REVISION 2024

Neighbourhood Plans need to be constantly monitored and reviewed to ensure they are up to date with planning laws and are in line with the policies in both the National Planning Policy Framework and the Central Lincolnshire Local Plan (CLLP). As both these documents have recently been revised it is now important that the Parish Council revise the BNDP.

Consequently, the Parish Council are asking the residents of Bassingham to take part in a short survey concerning future residential development needs to 2040.

The CLLP has designated Bassingham as a medium sized village with a minimum growth of 15% (97 dwellings) by 2040, 87 dwellings have already been built out or had planning permission granted.

As a result, the development of The Whites Lane Allocated Site is no longer needed to fulfil Bassingham's requirements under the CLLP. Any required future development beyond 2040 would be satisfied by the reserve site at Torgate Lane/Carlton Road.
